It's hard to believe that a year has passed since the first Night for Flight took place last November. Nearly \$9,000 was raised that evening that helped over 100 youth around the United States receive free flights.

We had a lot of complications with securing

an aircraft for the world flight we had planned for the summer for 2005 so the Eagle Flight team restructured; found an aircraft to do a U.S. tour with and continued looking for an aircraft for the global circumnavigation.

West Mesa Aviation of Albuquerque, NM

sponsored the Cessna 172 for this summer's flight and will also sponsor the aircraft for the world tour that departs next summer. I will be flying an aircraft that has never been flown around the world with a range of approximately 750 miles and a cruise speed of 150 mph.

What is the world's deepest lake?

How do you decide what route to take? (Matthew- ID.)

There are several factors to take into consideration when making such an extensive solo trip:

- Direction was chosen based on following the jet stream, trying to create a tailwind most of the way.
- With low altitude flying, deciding the safest route between Russia or the middle east will be a factor.
- Fuel capacity, available fuel and number of stops will determine what cities are chosen.
- Leaving June 17th allows for the longest daylight and best weather.
- Cost for landing fees, etc
